

PHOTO REPORT ON HUMANITARIAN ACTIVITIES

«SEE THE WORLD BRIGHTER»

In March 2014, the forthcoming humanitarian action was announced by the Corporation "DAEWOO INTERNATIONAL", the Korean organization "VISION CARE" and the Asian Institute for Culture and Development (IACD).

Venue: Fergana, Regional Ophthalmologic Hospital

The period: 14-16.04.2014 year (Fergana).

Project content: diagnostics and ophthalmic operations for patients living in the city of Fergana and districts of the Fergana region on a charitable basis.

On 3 factories of DTF, an announcement was made about the forthcoming humanitarian action.

Until 10.04.2014 the doctors of the Regional Ophthalmology carried out the selection and preliminary diagnosis of patients with vision problems (cataracts) and those requiring surgical treatment. Patients were also selected by doctors from district hospitals in the Fergana region. A total of more than 250 patients were selected at the end of the preliminary diagnosis.



On 14.04.2014, a delegation of Korean doctors and volunteers from the organization VISION CARE (8 people), 1 representative of Daewoo International, and 3 doctors from the Tashkent IACD clinic arrived in Fergana.

For the humanitarian action, a team of doctors brought the latest medical equipment for diagnosis and operations.

During the 4 days of the action, 8 employees of Daewoo Textile Fergana worked in the hospital as volunteers. The tasks of the volunteers included:

- monitoring the order of patients' queue, helping in the compilation of patient lists;
- assistance in the communication of physicians with patients (translation services), assistance in the process of diagnosis and postoperative examination, instructing patients;
- providing nutrition for a group of doctors, as well as distributing water and food to waiting patients and their relatives.

The administrative director of Daewoo Textile Fergana, Mr. Song Won Keng, supervised the entire process of the action. The President of the Company, Mr. Li So Il, also visited the hospital



Representatives of the Fergana regional television filmed a report on the humanitarian project with an interview with the chief surgeon, Mr. Kim Dong Hae, for the news program.



Korean ophthalmologists conducted a training course (presentation) for local doctors on innovative methods of surgical treatment of eye diseases.

RESULTS OF THE HUMANITARIAN ACTION:

In just 3 days "VISION CARE" physicians diagnosed more than 250 patients (many were prescribed and given glasses, medicines to maintain vision) and performed 84 operations to remove cataracts and replace the lens of the eyes.



After the end of the operation, the patients thanked the team of visiting doctors and volunteers for the opportunity to receive free treatment and restore their eyesight.



On 17.04.2014, after completing their mission at the regional ophthalmological hospital, Korean specialists VISION CARE visited the Fergana factory Daewoo Textile Fergana and expressed their gratitude to the President of the Company Mr. Li So Il and the volunteers for their support in organizing the humanitarian action.
